It was a privilege to restart Kids Club at Kerrybrook Apartments this summer. We met new children, reunited with those we already know, and had a wonderful time learning about creation, the Bible, and the life of Jesus. So many of the children attending were new to the club it was like starting from the beginning. The smiles on their faces, wonder in their eyes, and faithfulness with which they have attended was very precious for students and volunteers alike. We plan to continue the club this fall and would ask you to pray that going back to school would not bring case numbers of covid to students causing Kids Club to be put on hold again.



Teen Time was able to continue from the restart in April through the summer without interruption. Two of our students moved during the summer and we will miss them tremendously, however, these moves mean they are now in single family homes and that is a great thing for them. We wish them a wonderful school year and life moving forward. We have four young men and four young ladies faithfully attending weekly and two additional young ladies that are more sporadic. We studied a book this summer entitled, "<u>Believe</u>," providing daily Bible time for them and are beginning a new study for the fall in the Old Testament as requested by some of the students. Pray for the salvation of two young men and spiritual growth for all the others. One of our young men is still suffering from severe medical problems and we would ask you to pray for doctors to be able to diagnose his illness and give him the treatment he needs to bring him back to the lively, active life he once had. Our students are in grades seventh through twelfth. Please pray that we will be able to minister to them where they are and speak to their needs on a weekly basis.
