We have had a wonderful year of Kids Club, but it has been a year like no other. Two-thirds of our students enrolled, speak only Spanish. God, our awesome provider, gave our team 5 Spanish speaking leaders this year—one for each grade level and one to handle check-in and check-out of students. This new situation has caused us to rethink, replan, and restructure Kids Club for the 2024-25 school year. We are excited to see how God is working in the lives of children new to our country, new to our school, and new to the idea of God, Jesus, and learning about the Bible. We look forward to an even greater impact we can have on our students next year with the new plans we will be implementing.

Please pray for the students who are learning ten memory verses and the New Testament Books of the Bible to finish strong. We have several second through fifth graders that are working hard to complete the challenge of learning all their verses. Verses they are committing to memory this year are as follows: John 3:16, Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23, Ephesians 2:8-9, I Corinthians 15:3-4, Acts 16:31, I John 1:9, Joshua 1:9, Colossians 3:17, Ephesians 4:31-32, and Luke 6:31. We have studied New Testament Bible lessons Matthew through Revelation this year and students are becoming familiar with who Jesus is and what He did for us on the cross as well as what we can look forward to in the future.

We will celebrate the year of Kids Club in April with a pizza party. Awards will be given for those with perfect attendance for the year, those who have successfully completed the Bible memory challenge, and those who are moving on to middle school. Ann and Noemi have done a wonderful job of counseling all students with the gospel. Please pray that our students will remember lessons taught, verses learned, and apply them in their everyday lives going forward.



Kids Club students are eagerly anticipating going to His Hill Ranch Camp this summer in Comfort, TX. We have had the privilege of sending students on scholarship to a week-long Bible camp for over twenty years. It is an amazing experience for these kiddos, many of whom shed tears when they leave.
