YOU MAY BE WONDERING ABOUT MOLDOVA/UKRAINE?







We are still in touch with several Moldovans who are working with Ukrainian refugees and making trips into Ukraine carrying much needed supplies. The situation is still grave, but God is working in and through daily opportunities. It is our privilege to once again support Pastor Stas in the village of Maximovca by providing funds for he and his wife and their team to provide summer camp for approximately 70 youth from the ages of 6 to 18. Last year we were thrilled to hear that there were Moldovan, Romanian, AND Ukrainian youth at the camp. They minister to the youth as well as their families through the interactions they provide throughout the week at this camp.
