We are truly grateful for the thirty-two faithful volunteers that have helped with Kids Club and on campus during school days making this ministry possible in 2024/25.

April 8th, our Kids Club Team met to enjoy the fellowship of a meal together as we gave testimony and praise to the Lord for His amazing love, safety, and presence as we ministered to over fifty 2nd through 5th grade students.

Hi, my name is Aimee Neugebauer and many of you know me simply as “Joyce’s daughter”. I have worked part time at One Way International since 2016 but feel as though I’ve always been involved in children’s ministry in one way or another simply by existing in my family.

When I was school age, I remember spending many hours at the Child Evangelism Fellowship office on Blanco Rd as well as local, inner-city apartment complexes my family ministered to weekly. As a teen, I often spent my summers as a summer missionary in inner-city San Antonio. For many years, I also participated in after school Bible clubs at local apartments for elementary school age children where I enjoyed mentoring them in their school academics. In 1998, I traveled to Moldova as a summer missionary and still have fond memories of the people and culture there.

For the past 9 years, I have worked at One Way International as a Staff Assistant and in 2021 took on the role of bookkeeper.
